



Details
Problem: Existing relief valve cartridges have incorrect pressure settings.
Solution: Install new relief valve cartridges that have correct pressure settings.

WORK SAFELY!

Only a qualified service technician with proper training should perform this procedure. Follow all shop safety rules while performing this procedure.

PREPARATION

1. Make sure the trowel is turned off and **the engine is cool**.
2. Place the trowel in an area free of dirt and debris, and make sure it is on secure level ground.

REQUIRED TOOLS

- 5/16" Socket
- 1-1/4" Wrench or Socket

TROWEL SAFETY

⚠ CAUTION

- **NEVER** lubricate components or attempt service on a running machine.

ENGINE SAFETY

⚠ WARNING

- **NEVER** place hands or fingers inside the engine compartment while the engine is running.

⚠ CAUTION

- **NEVER** touch the **hot** exhaust manifold, muffler, or cylinder. Allow these parts to cool before servicing the equipment.



BATTERY SAFETY

⚠ DANGER

- **DO NOT** expose the battery to open flames, sparks, cigarettes, etc. The battery contains combustible fluids. If these fluids come into contact with a flame or spark, an explosion can occur.

⚠ CAUTION

- **ALWAYS** disconnect the **NEGATIVE** battery terminal before servicing the equipment.

BATTERY DISCONNECTION




Figure 2. Battery Disconnection

1. Remove and set aside the **LEFT** grill guard to gain access to the battery (Figure 2).

2. Disconnect the two negative (**BLACK**) cables from the negative terminal on the battery. See Figure 2.

FOOT PLATFORM REMOVAL




Figure 3. Foot Platform Hardware Removal

1. Using a 5/16" socket, remove and set aside the 15 screws securing the foot platform to the frame (Figure 3).




Figure 4. Foot Platform Removal

2. Remove the foot platform and set it **in front** of the trowel as shown in Figure 4. **DO NOT** disconnect or remove the foot pedal sensor cable.

NOTICE

MAKE SURE the foot pedal sensor cable remains **connected**. Disconnection of this cable will cause an electrical fault.

RELIEF VALVE CARTRIDGE REPLACEMENT




Figure 5. Relief Valve Cartridge Location

1. Locate the two relief valve cartridges (Figure 5) on top of the pump assembly.

NOTICE

Each relief valve cartridge sits next to a plug that is nearly identical to it. **DO NOT remove these plugs!** The relief valve cartridges to be removed are approximately 1/2-inch longer than the plugs sitting next to them. See Figure 5.




Figure 6. Relief Valve Cartridge Removal

- Using a 1-1/4" wrench or socket, remove and discard both relief valve cartridges (Figure 6A).




Figure 7. Relief Valve Cartridge Installation

- Insert the two new relief valve cartridges (P/N 42611-1) into the pump and torque them each to 60 ft-lb (81.35 N·m). See Figure 7.

TESTING AND REASSEMBLY

- Reinstall the foot platform with the hardware that was removed earlier.
- Reconnect the negative (**BLACK**) battery cables.
- Start the engine according to the instructions found in the STX6H operation manual. Allow the engine to run for a few minutes, and make sure there are no leaks.
